A broad range of services are provided to support the University campuses including: facility maintenance by all trades, capital maintenance, information technology systems for operations (work control, time capture, preventative maintenance), energy and utilities systems, recycling and waste management, event services, residential facilities coordination, grounds maintenance and facility condition assessment and tracking. Facilities Services plays a critical role in planning for the \$30M/year deferred maintenance investment.

What You'll Do

Reporting to facilities management, the Plumber I is responsible for all aspects of installation, maintenance, inspection, operation and repair of plumbing systems and will have extensive experience and knowledge with water, sewer, venting, medical and vacuum gas systems.

- Must have experience installing, troubleshooting, and servicing water filtering and humidification systems.
- The Plumber reads blueprints, drawings and specifications to determine the layout of plumbing systems, water supply networks and waste and drainage systems.
- The Plumber will then plan, install and service plumbing systems, fixtures, piping equipment and controls.
- This position performs similar or related duties as required. This position is considered essential as defined in the Tufts University Employee Handbook.
