Responsibilities

General Cleaning:

- * Appropriately disposes trash, compost, recyclables and other garbage from all dining service areas, cleans containers, trash collection areas and loading dock.
- * Hoses out garbage rooms in units that have garbage rooms as needed.
- * Sweeps, strips, mops, buffs, waxes and vacuums floors in laundry room, kitchen, dish room, serving line, offices, bathrooms, storerooms and docks.
- * Cleans and maintains supplies in all dining service bathrooms.
- * Cleans walls, baseboards, mats, drains and vents in kitchen and serving line.
- * Cleans glass windows and doors.
- * Cleans entryways and service lines.
- * Spot cleans carpets.
- * Washes pots, pans and utensils; puts clean items away. Washes steam jacketed kettles.
- * Operates and maintains pot washing machine, floor scrubber, buffer, water vacuum, vacuum cleaner, steam jacketed kettles, dish machine, portable steam cleaner, mops and brooms
- * Cleans equipment: refrigerators, dish machine, trayveyor, kettles and pots.
- * Works and directs staff in dish room and pot-washing areas.
- * Power washes carts, docks, trayveyor and dish room.
- * Assists in cleaning all food service equipment on a regular basis.
- * Safely uses cleaning chemicals.

Customer Service:

Provide customer service before and during meal periods to ensure availability to meet customer demand, including the following:

- * Maintains service and dining areas during meals periods.
- * Cleans up spills, keeps floors clear of debris, removes trash.
- * Maintains supplies of milk, soda syrup, CO2 and ice.
