Position Summary

The Learning Designer will support instructors directly through the creation of content and programming and individual consultations. The incumbent will serve as a liaison with the offices of Accessibility Resources and Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion. Essential to this role is advocacy and outreach to the campus instructional community promoting UDL and inclusive pedagogy.

- Serve as a UDL and Inclusive Course Design Expert in UBs LMS.
- Develop training and advocate for accessible pedagogy.
- Collaborate with campus partners in advocating for increased adoption of UDL guidelines.
- Serve on the classroom design and rehabilitation committee to advise on classroom accessibility features.
