has exceptional communication skills to be able to teach students, interns, residents and other fellow technicians in Fear-free restraint, positioning, imaging technique and safe sedation practices. Under the direct guidance of a senior veterinary technician or veterinarian, the Diagnostic Imaging Technician I is responsible for providing high quality nursing care and performing basic technical skills and procedures on a variety of patients. As part of our highly competitive benefits package, we offer a liberal continuing education allowance and tuition reimbursement program to all technicians employed in Foster Hospital for Small Animals in order to promote personal and professional growth. The minimum rate of pay for this position is \$22.50 per hour based off a 35-hour budgeted work week. Compensation above this rate will vary based on education, experience, and credentials. Generous shift differentials are offered for any scheduled hours worked outside of normal business hours, which are Monday through Friday 8am to 5pm, and range between an additional \$2-\$4 per hour. A substantial holiday premium pay is applied to any University designated holiday. The University observes a minimum of thirteen holidays throughout the calendar year.

#### Basic Requirements:

- High school diploma (or equivalent), and 2 years of experience as a veterinary assistant or veterinary technician, or similar technical experience

- Understanding of medical terminology, veterinary pharmacology, and common specialty surgical procedures
- Willingness to coach and train students

  - Assess the attitude and responsiveness of patients being treated
  - Obtain vital signs, including temperature, pulse, respiration, and capillary refill time
