What You'll Do

- Under the supervision of the program manager and in collaboration with a program administrator, the Student Programs Senior Coordinator provides support to multiple Tisch College student programs and affiliated clubs.
- The student programs Senior Coordinator plays an integral role in supporting our work to meet students where they are and engaging them throughout their time at Tufts.
- The Senior Program Coordinator will organize and maintain files/databases, update and track student and program information and oversee entry/maintenance of data.
- They will arrange logistics for meetings/seminars/lecturers/events.
- They plan travel, submit payments/reimbursements for students, speakers and presenters in collaboration with the Administrative support staff and University vendors.
- They will also be responsible for monitoring budgets and tracking spending.
- The Senior Program Coordinator will serve as a liaison between Tisch student programs team and student leaders, club members, and program participants; this includes managing correspondence, onboarding, attending events, and supporting content delivery for a subset of programs.
- They will support the hiring of student workers, teaching assistants, peer leaders and more across programs.
- They will attend team meetings, all-Tisch staff meetings, and other regular programming including events
