Job Description

The Department of Emergency Medicine is seeking a highly motivated and qualified individual for a research position focused on research addressing the opioid epidemic and priority areas for enhancing the systems of drug abuse prevention, treatment, and harm reduction in New York State. Specific projects include: Documenting the use of and assessing the effectiveness of fentanyl and xylazine test strips; Evaluating the effectiveness of telemedicine for providing medication?assisted therapy; Understanding the perspectives of individuals in opiate treatment and recovery peer support roles.

Faculty are affiliated with the MATTERS Network, which conducts harm reduction activities, telemedicine, and referrals. MATTERS is currently one of the largest distributors of fentanyl and xylazine test strips. There will be a focus on activities supporting the submission of grant applications and manuscripts to peer-reviewed journals, e.g., literature reviews, with opportunities for co-authorship. Training and mentorship will be provided by research faculty in Emergency Medicine and the Clinical and Research Institute on Addictions (CRIA).
