Facilities Services plays a critical role in planning for the \$30M/year deferred maintenance investment.

## What You'll Do

Reporting to facilities management, the Electrician I is responsible to assemble, install, test and maintain electrical or electronic wiring, equipment, commercial applications to ensure that such systems are functioning effectively and efficiently.

- The Electrician I must have experience diagnosing malfunctioning systems, equipment and components, using test equipment and hand tools, to locate the cause of a breakdown and correct the problem.
- The Electrician I is responsible for the connection of wires to circuit breakers, transformers, or other components.
