The **Hazardous Materials Technician** performs a wide variety of duties for **Environment, Health, and Safety (EH&S)**. The Hazardous Waste Technician has frequent oral and written communication with professional staff (Ph.D., MD, Senior Researchers, Lab Technicians), clerical staff (secretaries and clerks), physical plant staff (cleaners, shop personnel, etc.), graduate and undergraduate students, most university departments and outside vendors. The Hazardous Materials Technician reports directly to the Hazardous Materials Supervisor.

Thus, the Technician must:

- Communicate well with individuals.
- Independently recognize potentially unsafe conditions.
