- Perform spirometry testing after completing required training.
- Conduct home visits for enrollment if needed.
- Provide education on asthma management to students and parents.
- Manage study timelines, including scheduling follow-up surveys and other activities.
- Monitor participant safety throughout the study.
- Maintain adherence to recruitment goals and quality standards.
- Serve as the primary contact for study participants and their guardians.
- Input data into the RedCap system and extract relevant information from medical records.
- Monitor compliance with protocols and record any deviations.
- Assist with RedCap programming as needed.
- File required reports and submit amendments to the Institutional Review Board (IRB).
- Review adverse events and submit severe adverse event documentation.
- Perform additional tasks as required.
