- **Donor Engagement and Solicitation**: Engage and solicit donations from donors within a portfolio, using digital communication tools to renew and acquire annual contributions.
- **Research and Reporting**: Conduct research on donor groups using data and qualitative methods. Prepare and present findings to inform fundraising strategies.
- Content Creation and Opportunity Curation: Develop and adapt fundraising content to fit different platforms and audiences, ensuring it aligns with organizational goals.
- **Collaboration**: Work closely with teams in Donor Relations, Stewardship, Communications, and Annual Giving to ensure coordinated efforts.
