Responsibilities

A. Teamwork:

- Support Grounds Supervisor with onsite projects as needed.
- Learn how Athletics prepares and maintains fields and grounds for Athletics Competition.

B. Facility Support:

 Handle trash/compost/recycle from public Garden bins, sweep areas as needed, and pick up trash and debris.

C. Hardscape and Facility entry locations:

- Assess and address accessibility concerns along common walkways and entries to Athletic Facilities.
- Remove debris, operate blowers, and use pressure washers.
