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working directly with end user, capital planning group and facilities design and construction to oversee all renovation projects.

- Assigning space to faculty and staff according to CAS Space Policy. Coordinate or delegate conversations and services needed for physical moves within the College and execute those plans within schedule and budget constraints.
- Overseeing asset management and furniture/equipment disposal.
- Tracking and analyze classroom and teaching lab utilization.
- Serving as first point of contact for emergency management.
