- Work with the investigators, clinical and hospital staff, and the study coordinators.
- Ensure that IRB requirements are followed per approved study protocol protecting participant safety and ensuring the integrity of data collection.
- Perform data entry, develop and generate reports using Microsoft Access.
- Perform clinical exams on study participants per study protocol as needed
- Maintain the highest level of professionalism and perform any other duties necessary for the successful completion of the research study.
- Requires analytical and problem-solving skills, independent judgment, collaboration and initiative to accomplish goals.
- Ensure the accuracy of data collection and participants' assessments, and conduct quality assurance.
