GENERAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Under supervision, performs all duties related to the craft.
- Maintain a working knowledge of asbestos removal and hazardous waste handling, regulations and procedures.
- Safely handles, properly contains and labels, and follows appropriate emergency procedures as they relate to asbestos material.

- Removes and/or encapsulates asbestos containing materials.
- Replace and/or repair damaged and missing insulation.
- Has the ability to estimate footage and fitting counts for re-insulation projects.
- Correctly selects appropriate insulation for various jobs, taking into consideration project location and heat/or chill factors.
- The work requires setting up and using scaffolding and/or ladders to perform tasks above ground level: has the ability to gain access to work or work places that require the ability to work in hot, isolated, small/tight areas; able to gain access to work or maneuver around obstacles.

ADMINISTRATIVE AND TECHNICAL:

- Supports maintenance projects and programmatic work assignments.
- Coordinate work assignments with Craft Superintendents and/or Leads, Project Managers, Building Inspectors, and campus clients.
- Plans the methods and procedures required to complete abatement, insulation, and repair work on campus.
- Selects correct tools, techniques and methods for handling specific projects by applying thorough knowledge of University, Local, State, and Federal regulations and codes.
- Must be available to respond to emergencies as needed.
