Position Summary

UB Business and Entrepreneur Partnerships (BEP) is seeking a Business Development Manager (BD Manager) to foster Universitys innovative research and facilitate economic growth in the Western New York Community. The ideal candidate will be outcome-driven and thrive in a fast-paced environment. The BD Manager is comfortable with both academic and commercial partners, is capable of fostering and growing networks, and serves as a resource for creating, evaluating, positioning, and identifying partnering opportunities for commercially relevant translational research.

The BD Manager has a general understanding of medical devices, diagnostics, health informatics and drug development processes and the challenges associated with developing the aforementioned. In this role you will be part of the BEP team and principally support the Life Sciences programs which include the New York State Center of Excellence in Bioinformatics & Life Sciences (CBLS) and the Center for Advanced Technology in Big Data and Health Sciences (UBCAT).

The external facing responsibilities of this position will include corporate prospect identification, project development, partner engagement, managing related contracts and reporting, and client relationship management. Internal responsibilities will involve working with faculty, departments, core facilities and tech transfer to identify translational and commercial opportunities and developing strategies in collaboration with BEP leadership to facilitate university growth and increased revenue.

Key Responsibilities Include:

- Connecting Industry to University: Serve as a liaison to create and foster mutually beneficial partnerships by connecting Life Sciences programs, technical assets, and faculty expertise with industry needs inclusive of start-ups to drive innovation.
- Prospecting: Collaborate with BEP Marketing and the Life Sciences team to develop marketing and business development plans to increase visibility and promotion of university and BEP resources. Collaborate with other BEP Business Development Managers and leadership across other UB NYSTAR Centers to perform multi-channel outreach, leveraging internal and external referral networks, and attend, and exhibit at conferences, workshops and company meetings to identify and develop new prospects.
- Relationship Management: Build and maintain strong relationships with company partners and prospects, as well as faculty experts and service centers at the University at Buffalo to support CBLS, CAT and other Life Sciences activities. Work with companies and faculty to select and develop R&D project plans and proposals. Coordinate with internal units (such

as BEP Finance and Technology Transfer) to develop and formalize industry partnerships through contracts.

- Outreach and Education: Collaborate with internal and external parties on development and implementation of programming, marketing communications, and public relations activities related to business development, such as hosting conferences and seminars and production of multi-media marketing communications.
- Work closely with the Life Sciences team to execute tasks and deliverables including biannual reports to NYS and as required.
