This role plays a critical part in creating dynamic, engaging, and brand-aligned live event experiences that elevate the game day atmosphere and deepen fan engagement.

Working closely with marketing, sponsorship, and event operations teams, this position ensures the seamless integration of storytelling, promotional content, and live production elements. The Assistant Director oversees game presentation planning, directs in-venue video crews, and contributes to the overall creative direction of the department's visual identity. A passion for live sports production, attention to detail, and the ability to thrive in high-pressure environments are essential for success in this role.
