- Exporting bibliographic records from OCLC into ExLibris Alma Network Zone, creating holdings and item records in the local catalog (Institution Zone).
- Maintaining Alma holdings to reflect accuracy and currency.
- Performing complex authority work by creating and revising Name Authority Records to contribute to the Library of Congress Name Authority File.
