The Financial Administrator will be International Education's subject matter expert in managing international payments and will be the primary administrative liaison for UB's education abroad program travelers.

The **Financial Administrator's** responsibilities will include:

- Serving as a liaison with UB's central business offices and with faculty and staff engaged in international activities
- Reviewing and authorizing financial transactions for a portfolio of departmental accounts;

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- maintaining and reconciling accounts
- Managing payments for overseas programs, and working with travelers to manage complex expense advances and reimbursements
- Supporting student scholarship and fellowship payments
- Managing tuition remission for incoming international exchange students and inter-university tuition transfers for education abroad participants
- Helping prepare department, project-level and fee-for service budgets, and billing for departmental services
